Centre Development/Construction and Service Innovation

- Over \$20M in philanthropic funding partially raised through local fundraising campaigns
- Over \$2M in evaluation and research funding

Ongoing Operational Funds

- The Province of BC provides annualized funding (\$4-700k/yr) for operational costs, mental health, substance use or primary care services
- Existing community based health and social services are mobilized into each centre, adding \$750k-1.5M in resources per centre







TOOLBOX is an electronic system developed to enhance delivery of integrated care at Foundry centres as well as support evaluation, quality improvement and research activities






CORE SERVICE STREAMS






