ParmaWelfare

The objective of ParmaWelfare is twofold: to provide support and "light" home care services to fragile people in the Parma District, and to stimulate the activation and participation of citizens as volunteers.

The Project is organized around the Punti di Comunità (Community Points): physical places located in the different districts of the city around which the volunteers and part of the activities gather. Currently, there are 10 places existing. It is focused on building proximity, between citizens, service providers, growing the network of services for a specific family.



Governance team

The project is being managed through a Control Room which meets at least monthly and which sees representatives of all the partners of the agreement. In this sense, the management is collegial and is then operationally translated. The project leader is supported by an operational Coordinator and four facilitators, each active in specific areas of the city with coordination roles on the Community Points and activation of the resources of the Associations present in that territory.

The team works very closely and there is very little hierarchy involved, to make sure that everyone understands the vision and can implement it.
